Under this agreement for 2018 Richmond Hill State School will receive

\$194,274*

This funding will be used to

- Improve PM reading levels of students in Prep Year 3 who are below NQR Benchmarks from 75% to over 85% in the next two years, through the Levelled Literacy Intervention program.
- Increase the percentage of Years 3 and 5 students meeting NAPLAN National Minimum Standards in Spelling, Grammar and punctuation from 75% 85%.
- Improve the average percentage of students' results in Mathematics to 'C' or above in Years 1, 2 and 3 from 85% to 95%.
- Embed identified research based high-yield strategies and develop a positive support culture between staff through the implementation of instructional coaching, mentoring, observing and a feedback cycle using key staff as instructional leaders.
- Support students with disabilities and their teachers in reaching identified learning goals.
- Achieve 85% of Prep Year 3 students reaching the NQR PM Benchmark Target by the end of the year.
- Provide support for student/parent transition to Prep.

Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher and teacher aide skills through focused PD opportunities to meet current reading needs.
- Develop staff knowledge, understanding and skills to improve the grammar, spelling and punctuation of students through integrated writing activities.
- Funding a pedagogical coach to support specific improvement pedagogy practices schoolwide.
- Deliver an intensive reading program to meet the needs of identified students.
- Fund a part-time Pre-Prep teacher to run a Pre-Prep program for the Richie community, to improve transition to prep at Richie.
- Develop a culture of collaboration through the implementation of training and developing classroom mentors/coaches to work weekly with teachers. This will assist in lifting confidence in planning and delivering quality pedagogy and assessment.
- Develop high yield strategies in mathematics through quality coaching/mentoring/PD through a feedback cycle. A term by term schoolwide focus will drive this initiative.
- Deliver a reading program that builds capacity in all students through data driven strategies.

Providing a part-time early childhood teacher to support the school's KIPPAR Pre-Prep Program.	\$ 15,274
